

Plant Options That Deer "Usually" Don't Eat

*Liquid oil-based repellants do work but need do be reapplied after it

rains.

*Putting a fence around young apple trees will help keep the deer from eating the apple buds and from scraping the truck.

*FYI...If deer are hungry enough, they will eat pretty much anything.
